

For safety and efficiency reasons, Holy Spirit Catholic School District would like to reduce the amount of Cash & Checks coming into our school. School Cash Online is our school's preferred method of payment. Please join the thousands of parents who have already registered and are enjoying the convenience of paying ONLINE! It takes less than 5 minutes to register. Please follow these step-by-step instructions, so you will begin to receive email notifications regarding upcoming events involving your child(ren).

NOTE: If you require assistance, select the SUPPORT option in the top right hand corner of the screen.

Step 1: Register

- a) If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page https://holyspirit.schoolcashonline.com/ and select the "Get Started Today" option.
- b) Complete each of the Registration Steps
 *For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters,
 one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account.

The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name
- b) Enter the School Name
- c) Enter Your Child's Name & Birth Date
- d) Enter Your Child's ASN (available from your school)
- e) Select Continue
- f) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select *Continue*
- g) Your child has been added to your account

Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" option and repeat the steps above. 5 children can be added to one parent account.

If you do not wish to add additional children, select

"View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.






ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI

St. Francis of Assisi was a Catholic friar who gave up a life of wealth to live a life of poverty. He was born in Assisi, Italy in 1182 and grew up leading a privileged life as the son of a wealthy cloth merchant. Around the age of nineteen, Francis went to battle against the nearby town of Perugia. He was captured and taken prisoner. He was held prisoner in a dungeon for a year before his father paid the ransom and he was set free. God later called Francis to devote his life in serving the poor. He also had a love for animals and was known to talk and preach to them. He established the Franciscan order of friars and the women's Order of the Poor Ladies. Two years after his death, he was declared a saint of the Catholic Church.

Did you Know?

"Encyclical" means "circular letter." They are formal letters written by the popes, meant for teaching.

1) Response to the Cry of the Earth

Pope Francis took his papal name after St. Francis of Assisi; patron saint of ecology. Laudato Si was issued in 2015 to encourage us to be "protectors of creation, protectors of God's plan inscribed in nature, protectors of one another and of the environment."

7) Community Engagement and **Participatory Action** We must "realize that the world is a gift

which we have freely received" and protect it together for future generations by living sustainably, in our community and in our world.



6) Ecological Spirituality

Laudato Si comes from the first line of St. Francis' Canticle of the Sun, which praises God for the beauty of creation. We should encounter the natural world with wonder, praise, joy and gratitude.



As protectors of one another, Pope Francis

calls us to also defend life, from conception to natural death, as well as all forms of life on Earth. We should take special care of vulnerable and marginalized groups.

2) Response to the Cry of the Poor

5) Ecological Education

In Laudato Si, Pope Francis calls us to talk about and address the environment. We need to promote ecological vocations among our youth.

3) Ecological Economics

All of our activities have an impact on the world around us. We have to consider prayerfully how we balance satisfying our needs with protecting our environment.

4) Adoption of Simple Lifestyles

Pope Francis is concerned about our level of consumerism. We need to be aware of how we use energy and resources.


