## KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST

Please supply your child with the following items for the kindergarten school year.

- 1 **LARGE** backpack to carry items between home and school
- 1 large pencil case (Appr 11x7x3) large enough to hold markers, crayons, scissors, glue
- 1 set of markers (preferably CRAYOLA short, skinny "Pip Squeak" markers)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 pair of children's scissors
- 1 eraser
- 1 small bottle of white liquid glue
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 exercise notebook, ½ plain ½ interlined
- 1 one-inch binder (label spine of binder with student name)
- 30 top loading plastic sheet protectors (please insert these into the 1" binder)
- 1 package of 100 or more craft pony beads
- 1 small bottle of glitter glue, any color
- 1 package of craft materials of own choice to be shared with classmates (ex. Stickers, cotton balls, envelopes, buttons, ribbons, yarn/string, paper bags)
- 2 four oz containers of "Play-Doh" brand playdough
- 1 backpack pouch for bringing papers to & from school (zippered folder)
- 1 pair of non-marking gym runners
- 1 complete change of clothing to be left in your child's backpack, in labeled plastic bag
- Water bottle to bring back and forth from home to school each day
- 1 box of Kleenex (morning class)
- 1 package paper plates (afternoon class)
