FEBRUARY 2026

As we transition into February 2026, our school community begins to prepare for the holy season of Lent: a profound 40-day journey of reflection, repentance, and spiritual renewal. Metaphorically speaking, we can think of this time as a "desert-like experience" where we aim to step away from the hustle, busyness, and noise of daily life, in order to engage in a deeper sense of contemplation and spiritual renewal before the Easter season.

While it can be common during this season of sacrifice to abstain from simple comforts such as sugar, chocolate, or a favorite TV program, our leadership team invites you to join us in a deeper inquiry this Lent by asking yourself one key question, what truly needs to change in my life to place God at the center of my life? If we arrive at the joy of Easter Sunday having only abstained from sweets and treats without meaningful experiences of journeying closer to the heart of Jesus, we may have missed the transformative power this season has to offer.

To guide this journey of spiritual growth, we look at the three pillars from Matthew's Gospel: Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. As we discuss this season in our classrooms, we emphasize that these are not merely rituals, but essential teachings from Jesus in our faith journeys. As highlighted in the Ash Wednesday Gospel of Matthew 6, we are called to practice these virtues with humility and sincerity.

- Through Fasting, we learn to curb and deny the desire for immediate pleasures.
- Through Almsgiving, we overcome the pull of possession by sharing our time and resources.
- Through Prayer, we inhibit pride, making room for a more intimate and authentic relationship with our Lord.

These disciplines invite us to "open wide the doors" of the Gospel and share Christ's love with one another and our school community as we seek to support one another's Lenten journey. Finally, as we move into February, we want to take a moment to pause and just say: Thank you! We feel a profound sense of gratitude and fulfillment as we continue through this school year watching our students "grow and glow" while they discover, develop, and share their talents both inside and outside of our school community. As a school, we are excited to facilitate this season of faithful communion through our student-led liturgies, and we warmly invite our families and all stakeholders to join us during these sacred gatherings. By attending, you will witness the tremendous joy and leadership that our students demonstrate daily through their minds, hearts, and actions. Our goal is that by the time we reach the Holy Triduum in April, we aren't just celebrating the end of another Lenten season, but rather honoring a community that moved together toward a deeper commitment to place the Gospel teachings and the transformative love Jesus offers truly at the center of our lives.

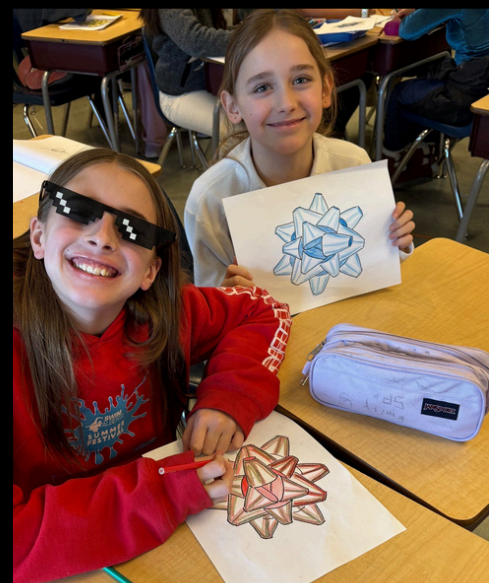
Thank you to our

The Grade 5 students created realistic Christmas bows using pencil crayons and explored contrast colours and blending. They turned out beautifully. Well done!

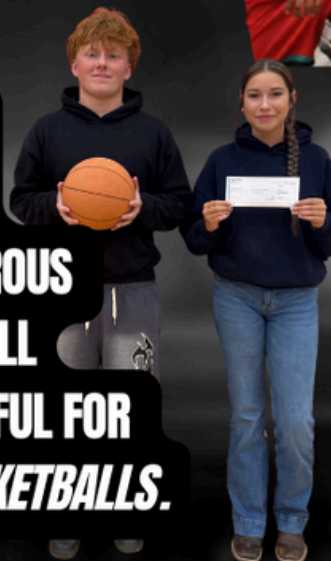

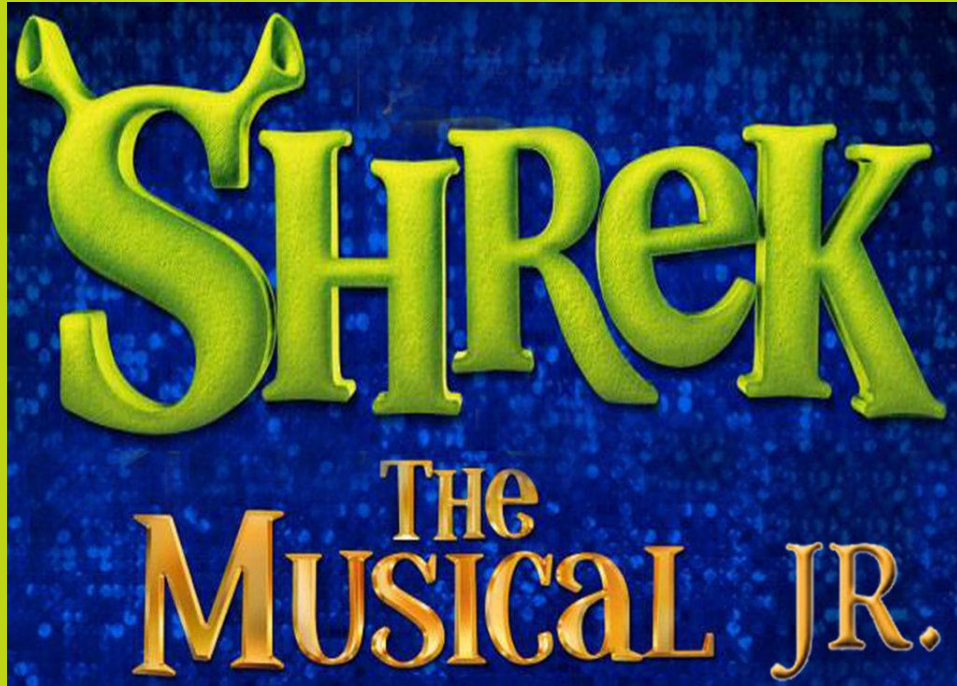



U4-U6 Timbits: An introduction to soccer. All sessions ran by LSA Staff Coaches, with activities based around players exploring the soccer ball and getting comfortable with an invasion sport. Some small sided scrimmages may be played, but this environment is purely about the players gaining their first touches of a soccer ball.

U8-U10 Fundamental: Individual development is paramount by building a love of the ball. Sessions will challenge players creative side as well introduce them to skills needed in the game such as dribbling, passing and shooting. Scrimmages will be played, but no scores will be kept, and all players will be asked to experience all positions of a soccer match (goalkeeper, defender, midfielder, striker).

U12-U14 Learning The Game: This age is classed as 'The Golden Age Of Learning' where skills learnt in the earlier stages are now enhanced as well as an introduction to the tactical side of the game. Scrimmages will be played and although scores will be kept during the game, coaches and players are asked to keep games meaningful, competitive and to avoid blowouts at all costs. There will be no league standings.

U16-U18 Excel In The Game: Utilizing the technical understanding and tactical skills learnt in the previous three phases to excel in the game. Like the previous 'Learning the Game' phase, coaches are asked to avoid blowouts and keep games competitive throughout.

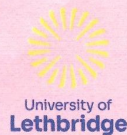

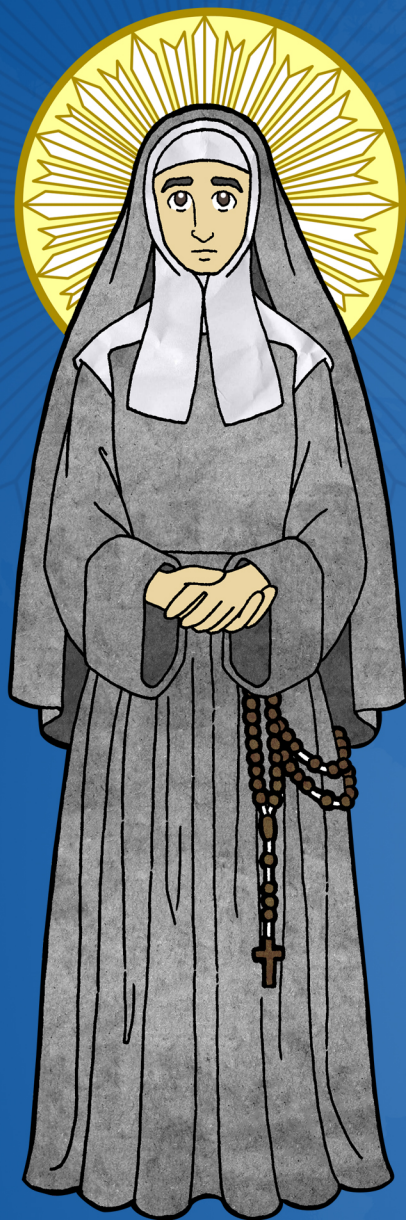


PARKING
