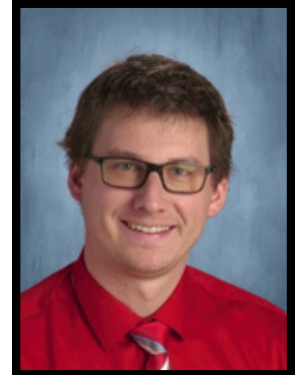

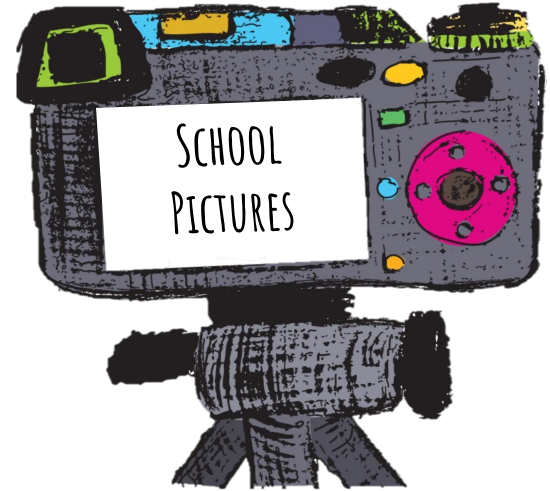


Knights of Columbus®
