The Funeral

- Pope Francis’s funeral was on Saturday morning in Rome. Because of the time difference, it was very early in the morning in Alberta—at 2:00 a.m.
- People from all over the world went to Rome to say goodbye, pray, and thank God for Pope Francis’s life.
- After the funeral, the Church will have nine special days of prayer, called Novendiales, to remember and honor him.
- After those days, the cardinals—who are Church leaders—will meet in a special gathering called the conclave to choose a new pope. Let’s remember to pray for the cardinals, that the Holy Spirit will help them choose a kind and faithful new leader for the Church.



- Pope Francis's funeral was a special time of prayer. People around the world joined together to thank God for his life and pray for him.
- The funeral was a Catholic Mass with Bible readings, a talk about his life, Holy Communion, and incense.
- Many cardinals, Church leaders, and world leaders attended, wearing red robes. In the videos, you may also see the Swiss Guard, the guards who protect the Pope and you will see the streets filled with people from all over the world praying quietly.
- Even though we may feel sad, we also feel hope—because we believe Pope Francis is now with Jesus in heaven, and we remember the love and joy he gave to others.

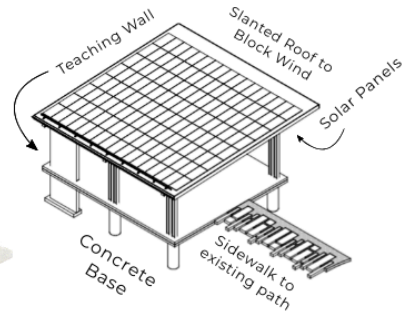

Meeting our next fundraising goal of \$15,000 means starting the first phase this summer.

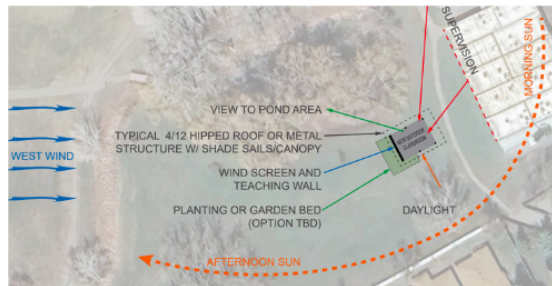
