

June Principal's Message

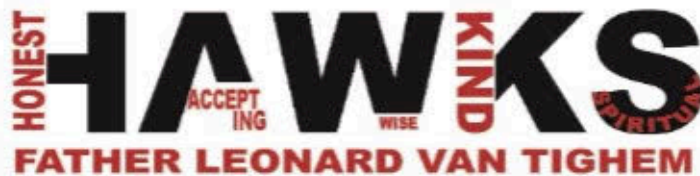

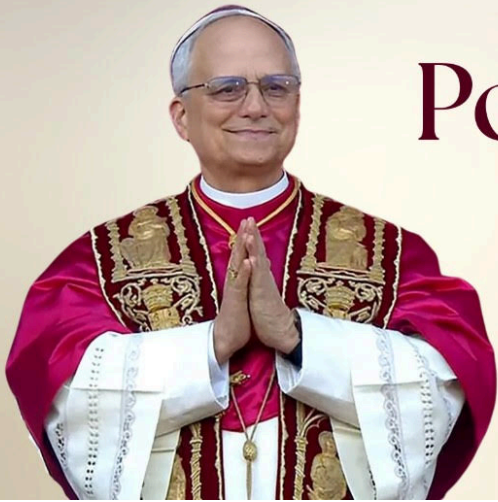

From the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, **Pope Leo XIV** smiled and waved to the crowd. He started with a simple and loving message: **"Peace be with you all."** He spoke gently and kindly to people around the world, saying how important it is for everyone to work together in peace, even when they are different. He said God wants us to be united, to care for one another, and to always be kind—especially to those who are poor or hurting.

Pope Leo XIV also thanked the people of Peru, where he lived and worked as a priest for many years, helping others and sharing God's love. He said the people there taught him a lot about faith, joy, and generosity. At the end of his message, he asked everyone to pray for peace—in our hearts, in our families, and in the whole world. He reminded us that Jesus loves everyone, and that we are all part of God's family.
