KING CHARLES IS ON THE CANADIAN DOLLAR

You may start finding loonies in your pocket with images of King Charles' face stamped on them.

After the passing of Queen Elizabeth in September 2022, her son, now King Charles, was next in line for the throne. In late 2023, it was on Canadian currency, according to announced that King Charles' effigy a study done by Angus Reid would be pressed into all Canadian Institute, 62% of Canadians are coins, starting with the dollar.

While it is not mandatory for Canadian currency to display the current monarch, it is tradition. Over 350 artists and engravers submitted work to be reviewed by the Royal Canadian Mint in order for the effigy of King Charles to be selected. The winning artist, Steven Rosati, has designed several other coins. The design needed to include a left-facing side profile, contrary to the rightfacing side profile of Queen Elizabeth II. The Royal Canadian Mint has used Canadian artists to design their coins since the 1990s as a way to demonstrate talent.

As confirmed by Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, King Charles III will also begin showing his face on the \$20 bill likely beginning in mid-2024.

Despite the country moving on Canadian currency, according to a study done by Angus Reid Institute, 62% of Canadians are Some Canadians. against it. according to the same study, even oppose recognizing Charles as king, however, others see this as an important and historic event. According to Alex Reeves, a spokesperson for the Royal Canadian Mint, this is the first time that Canadians under 65 years of age will have seen such a significant change made to Canadian currency. "To be able to be part of that transformation of our currency - and to create a design that's going to be beautifully executed and will grace Canadian coins for years to come — is a really special moment," Reeves stated in a CBC interview.

FLVT's Most Popular Water Bottle







Lebron James is also known for being one of the best basketball players of all time. He is a four time NBA champion as well as a four time NBA MVP. He currently plays for the LA Lakers.




